WESLEYAN YOUTH STANDING RULES

1. Honorary awards will be presented annually to the following:
 - a. The Outstanding Male and Female teen.
 - b. The Outstanding local WY group.

***Nominations for "Outstanding Teen" and "Local WY Group" are to be sent to the WY president two weeks prior to Youth Camp. All recipients will be selected by a committee appointed by the district youth cabinet and announced during Youth Camp.*

2. Each local church shall be asked to support the ministries of the District WY through a minimum Fair Share Assessment based on the formula appearing below, with all such funds used to underwrite WY promotions and programs.

3. The District WY Secretary, in cooperation with the District WY President and the District Secretary, will review and approve all minutes before they are submitted for publication in the District Conference Journal.
4. Annual written reports must be sent to the WY president two weeks prior to the WY Convention by the president, treasurer, secretary, and program coordinators.
5. The mileage rate for District WY business will be \$0.25 per mile. If an individual chooses not to be reimbursed, a receipt for tax purposes may be issued.
6. The Resolutions Committee shall annually review the WY Standing Rules and report to the WY Convention. The Resolutions Committee shall consist of three members elected by the WY Convention, and the WY President, who shall serve as chairman. Resolutions may be submitted from any local WY or Zone Executive Committee.
7. No two people from any one local church shall be allowed to serve on the District WY cabinet except the church of the District WY President and the teen representatives.
8. In addition to these Standing Rules, the VA WY operates in accordance with the Constitution of District Wesleyan Youth of The Wesleyan Church. (Discipline, Appendix F, paragraphs 7550-7600)

9. Two male teens and two female teens shall be elected by the Virginia District youth conference to serve on the Virginia District youth cabinet. Only one teen from a local church shall be allowed to serve. A teen may not serve two consecutive years.

10. Financial scholarships will be given to two students attending Wesleyan colleges/churches. Applications must be sent to the District Youth President no later than two months prior to youth camp. Scholarships will be awarded on overall character and will not be determined by gender, race, etc. Only graduating high school seniors who are enrolling in college in the fall of the same calendar year will be allowed to apply for this scholarship. Scholarships will be \$200 each and will be issued in both the school's name and the recipient's name.
