

What to Bring

Please label clothes and personal items

- ✓ Good Attitude
- ✓ Bedding (sheets, blanket, or sleeping bag and pillow)
- ✓ Personal items (toothbrush & tooth paste, soap)
- ✓ Towels and wash cloths
- ✓ BIBLE
- ✓ Paper and pencils
- ✓ A jacket for cooler evenings (check forecast)
- ✓ A stamped envelope
- ✓ Flashlight
- ✓ Swimsuit and cover-ups (no two piece suits), sunscreen
- ✓ Tennis shoes . . . A MUST!!

Take 460 to Appomattox. Take a left on Rt. 24 still going towards Appomattox. Go through Appomattox Battlefield Park (still on Rt. 24), take a right onto Rt. 60 towards Richmond. Go through Buckingham Courthouse. The campground is about 5-6 miles after this. You will pass a high school and new middle school on your left and then you will need to turn left before the red light. If you get to a red light turn around. There is a sign that says Nazarene Campground. After you turn left, you will go about 1-2 blocks to the entrance. Upon arrival please check in at the tabernacle in the center of camp.
